The manuscript page and the handwriting indicate that Nobel wrote this lyrical fragment of four rhymed couplets at the same time as he drafted “En gåta” (a Swedish version of A Riddle), at a guess sometime in the 1860’s. It is a melancholy, retrospective poem, and the motif of the daydreamer’s longing for an Aladdin’s lamp in the concluding line can be interpreted as the poet’s unavailing desire for creativity and love.

Abel Prize. The Abel Prize is a Norwegian prize, named after Norwegian mathematician Niels Henrik Abel (1802–1829), and awarded annually by the King of Norway to one or more outstanding mathematicians. It is modelled as a replica of the Nobel prize and comes with a monetary award of 6 million Norwegian kroner (NOK) (€635,000 or \$740,000).
