A bent, kinked, twisted or torn suspension spring can cause a clock to stop. If the spring looks damaged at all it should be replaced. If a clock has a wobbly pendulum it is often caused by a twisted or partially torn spring. Like hand washers you can and should purchase a good assortment of suspension springs.

Repair the moon dial if it is not working correctly. Face the clock and remove the top side panel. Open the door on the side or remove the panel from the back access section. Look inside at the back side of the dial to locate the click spring. Place your pointer finger on the tip of the click spring.

If your clock has a "silent lever", activate it and then move the minute hand clockwise until the clock reads the correct time. If you do not have a "silent lever", move the hands clockwise, pausing every chime or strike cycle, until the correct time is reached. Ensure the clock hands are not touching each other.
