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The 2014 CLSI guidelines retained the current MICs for cefazolin against enterobacteriaceae, but specified that susceptible results were based on a dosing regimen of 2 grams intravenously every 8 h and is specific for non-urine isolates . One of the major changes included in these guidelines involves the reporting of a urine-specific cefazolin MIC for enterobacteriaceae (susceptible ≤ 16 mcg/mL).

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Opinions in the guidelines differ on setting cutoff levels (i.e., 97.5th vs. 99th percentile for normally distributed data). All guidelines cover testing of anticoagulated patients, more detail being given by BCSH and CLSI, who suggest that Taipan snake venom time is a useful adjunct test in patients receiving vitamin K antagonists.

Subsequently, a reassessment of cefepime breakpoints identified clinical failures for isolates with cefepime MICs of 4 and 8 g/ml when lower doses were used, leading to the reduction of the susceptible cefepime breakpoint for Enterobacteriaceae from 8 to 2 g/ml in the CLSI 2014 guidelines (2). The "intermediate" category (4 to 8 g/ml) was replaced by the "susceptible-dose-dependent" (SDD) category (Table 2)(2).
