A second problem with the skills-and-strategies approach is that there is little evidence to support it. Strategy-oriented training has been found to improve reading performance, but only in certain limited contexts, for example second as opposed to foreign languages and post-secondary as opposed to secondary institutions (Pionsky 2011).
