### Sixth grade Lesson Multiples and Least Common Multiples (LCM)

No. LCM stands for Least Common Multiple. A multiple is a number you get when you multiply a number by a whole number (greater than 0). A factor is one of the numbers that multiplies by a whole number to get that number. example: the multiples of 8 are 8, 16, 24, 32, 40, 48, 56...

### LESSON Problem Solving 5-1 Least Common Multiple

The Least Common Multiple of a set of whole numbers is the smallest multiple common to all whole numbers in the set. To find the Least Common Multiple of two or more whole numbers, follow this procedure: Make a list of multiples for each whole number. Continue your list until at least two multiples are common to all lists.

### Multiples and Least Common Multiples - Math Goodies

Find the greatest common factor of two whole numbers less than or equal to 100 and the least common multiple of two whole numbers less than or equal to 12. Use the distributive property to express a sum of two whole numbers 1-100 with a common factor as a multiple of a sum of two whole numbers with no common factor.

### Sixth grade Lesson Finding the Least Common Multiple (LCM)

"For example, 15 is a multiple of 5, because 15 divided by 5 is 3. 49 is a multiple of 7, because 49 divided by 7 is 7." Write the number 5 on the board. Say several numbers and ask students to give you a thumbs up or a thumbs down if the number is a multiple of 5. Tell students that today they will be finding the least common multiple of two numbers.
