Symptoms vary depending on the type of nerves—motor, sensory, or autonomic—that are damaged. Motor nerves control the movement of all muscles under conscious control, such as those used for walking, grasping things, or talking.

It affects the feet and legs first, followed by the hands and arms. Neuritis is a general term for inflammation of a nerve or the general inflammation of the peripheral nervous system. Symptoms depend on the nerves involved, but may include pain, paresthesia (pins-and-needles), paresis (weakness), hypoesthesia (numbness), anesthesia, paralysis, wasting, and disappearance of the reflexes.

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
