In modern times, the familiar Western layout, left-to-right horizontal Chinese, has become more popular in regions using Simplified Chinese such as in the People's Republic of China, where the government mandated left-to-right writing in 1955, although the vertical format is still used for effect or where space requires it, such as signs or on spines of books . Similar to Latin-letter text, the horizontal rows are read from left to right, then top of the page to the bottom.
